

HISTORY OF THE GODMOBILE MINISTRY

In the beginning, Andy and Bobby Lue Zedwick had a stationary booth at the Lincoln County (Oregon) Fair to evangelize. In 1988 the Zedwick's prayed for helpers. The LORD led Lieselotte and Paul Jenkins to be involved and gave the Jenkins' the vision in 1989 to build a *booth on wheels*. The Zedwick's and Jenkins' have labored together to develop the Godmobile Ministry.

Then, Ray and Loragene Philpot became loyal friends of the Ministry, providing financial support and helping to build additional units. After witnessing the LORD at work in the first Godmobile Ray Philpot was led to build the second unit. The same testimony led Ray Philpot and Paul Jenkins to build Godmobile #3 for Andy and Bobby Lue Zedwick to cover additional fairs and festivals.

Then, the team built Godmobile #4 which worked one season in Oregon, went for short stint to the Seattle area, returned to Oregon, and in 1997 was assigned to Central Oregon. Unit #5 followed shortly thereafter.

Godmobile #4 was taken by Robert Falley to the USA National Convention in Arizona. The Tucson Chapter caught the vision and bought Godmobile #4 on the spot. Falley then asked the team to build Unit #6 to cover his Central Oregon and Southern Idaho area.

In 1997, due to health and age, Bobby Lue and Andy Zedwick retired and transferred Unit #3 to the Salem Chapter, FGBMFI. Their hearts and prayers are still with the Ministry. Since then, the Salem Chapter sold Unit 3 to the Spokane Chapter and Salem Chapter purchased Unit 8.

Many men and women from various chapters and churches have provided steadfast support in prayer, provision, and worked as co-laborers. The list is too long to acknowledge all of the wonderful folks with whom the founders have hugged and cried and laughed while standing shoulder to shoulder in this Ministry.

Space does not allow a listing of all the people who have bought or built Godmobiles or will be buying or building Godmobiles in the future.

A special note of appreciation to the many pastors and lay ministers (men and women) for faithfully discipling the thousands of new believers who received their salvation through the Godmobile Ministry.
